From the Pres...

Due to the uncertainties of taxiway construction at Waukegan Airport this year, we made an early decision to cancel the Young Eagle rally at the Airshow this year. Instead, we will operate an information booth to educate people on EAA and the Young Eagles program. This display is expected to include both a project under construction and a completed aircraft. I thank in advance Dave Smith and Dan Feldman for their help in providing these exhibits so that we can explain what EAA is all about.

In addition, we will take reservations for the upcoming 2012 Young Eagle rallies. Reservations will be limited, and we will base our capacity on the number of pilots committed to the rally dates. Chief Pilot Bob Herrick is currently polling our Young Eagle pilots to see who will be available. If he has not contacted you by now, please contact him at the number listed in our directory.

To make up for the loss of the Airshow rally, Skip Goss has graciously offered to host a second Rally at Skill aviation. This will be in addition to our previously scheduled Rally at Skill on October 6. The added date is September 22. I have included this event to the attached calendar.

Information you need to know if you plan to volunteer for the airshow:

Be prepared to talk about EAA and/or Young Eagles to interested visitors to the Airshow. We have handouts to give to interested people, but this is about promotion, not freebees!

We need 1-2 people to take reservations for the last 2 Rally dates. This consists of assigning the perspective YE a time slot on the selected day, recording their name and contact information (in case we need to contact them), and filling out a reservation card for them to keep as a reminder of their scheduled flight.

If you plan to volunteer, you must be at the display location by 8:00 AM this Saturday. I will have wrist bands to hand out at that time. If you arrive much later, you risk having to pay the gate fee to get in. There are no refunds!

We need to heavily staff the display from 9:00 until the Airshow. During the show and after, just a light staff is needed for security. Tear down is 5:00.

Lunch is not expected to be provided for us this year. If that changes, I will let you know.

Wear either the YE tee shirts we provided or your Chapter shirt. Either is appropriate for this event. We are promoting both.

We will be in Hangar A of Landmark Aviation. This is in the main terminal building, and is the large hangar on the west end of the building. It is near the food vendors. To enter, go across the main airport paved parking lot and through the open gate. The hangar is on the left. We will be at the front of the hangar, probably on the right side.

Finally, call or e-mail me to confirm that you are coming by Friday noon so that I can get parking passes and an idea of how many are planning on helping out. I have included my cell number in the membership directory listed on page 4. Thanks for your help!

Remember to call or email the prez by noon Friday if you plan to help staff our information booth Saturday!

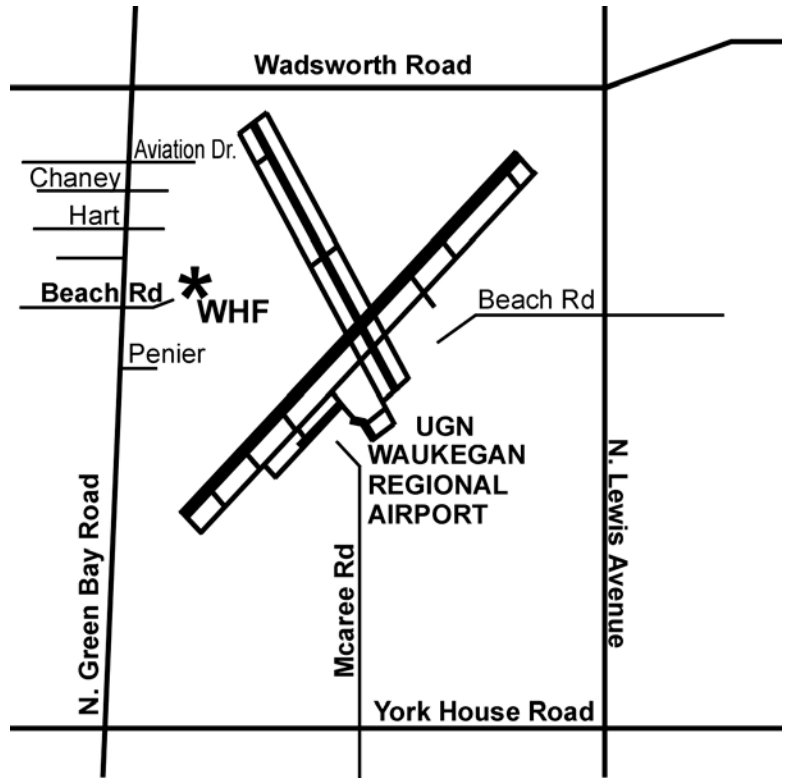
