The general discussion was related to the upcoming Chapter 414 Fly-In on June 15, 2014. Paul Wood was in attendance to provide comments on the how the Fly-In would be held.

General Comments:

- We need to ensure area is clean following the Fly-In
- The WHF aircraft will be positioned around the hangar walls
- We should consider Porta-Potties
- We should speak to Landmark Aviation to find out if they have any other activities that day that may impact the ramp area.
- Paul indicated that it would be okay if guests come in to the office area to look at the photos and such and to the use the restroom or cool off in the A/C. Generally we would not like to encourage the guest congregating in the office.
- Concerns regarding parking aircraft on the ramp – only one way in and one way out. Coordination will be imperative.
- We have the airport approval to park aircraft on the turf if we need the space.
- The chapter should designate members to provide security for the museum's aircraft.
- No need for a visitor log
- We might have several of Paul W. friends attend in their warbirds.
- Follow up on permits with 4<sup>th</sup> Port District and insurance (similar to B17 insurance)
- Confirmed that it will be acceptable to leave access gate open during the Fly-In
- Jim Coskey to provide a list to the officers at next chapter meeting indicating the volunteers that have committed to helping at the Fly-In.
- The chapter will provide soda and water – no need for other beverages
- Need to identify people to take photos during the Fly-In. Sam B. might take photos, Collin Feldman may be available. Sam mentioned reaching out to the Lake County Camera Club for volunteers.
- Jim Coskey spoke about getting a hotdog vending cart from the Vienna distributor.
- Mike and Dani Rogers have volunteered to marshal aircraft.
- We need to determine what fuel will be available and where? Will it be self-service or bring a truck over? Discount offered?
- Sam B. to divide up the membership roster and provide a list to each committee member. The committee member to reach out and speak to those members on the list to determine if they would like to volunteer.
- Jim Coskey to check on if food permits are required.
- Will the porta potties have wash stations? We need to ensure we have hand washing stations available to food service folks.
- Can Klein set up a corridor through the Mode C airspace?
- Builders tour in May, no meeting on May 8<sup>th</sup>.

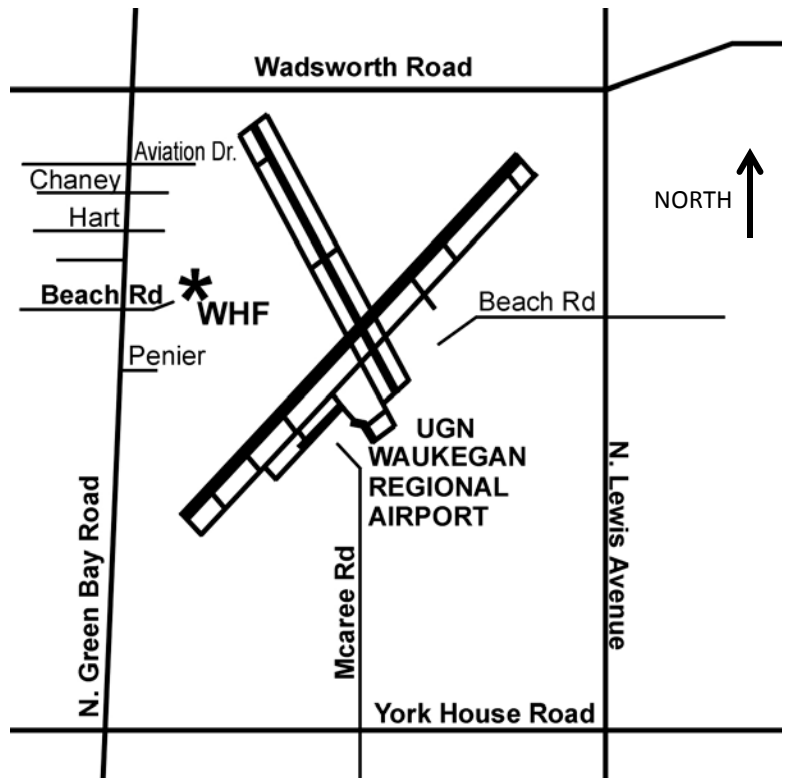
