May and June are shaping up to be really busy months, so pay close attention and put the dates on your calendar. Due to the heavy activity, there will be no regular business meetings at WHF during these 2 months as we take Chapter 414 on the road!

First up is the road/air trip to East Troy, WI airport (57C) to see the Warbird Heritage's Corsair. This addition to the fleet is undergoing a multi-year restoration. Tab-Air is responsible for the project, and Sam Tabor is graciously opening the doors of the workshop to let us take a peek at the progress. In addition to the Corsair, there are several other warbirds undergoing restoration. A homebuilder's paradise.

The event is this **Saturday, May 2**, as previously announced. Tour time is 2-4 pm.

If you are driving, one way to get there is to take WI Route 20 from I-94 west to East Troy. The airport is on your left as you approach East Troy. (If you pass under I-43, you just passed the airport) The airport may not show up on a GPS. Use the address of 2085 County Road L to locate it. Enter the airport, and go left towards the north hangars. Park outside the security gate. We are in Hangar L. If you need assistance, call me or Dave McCormick (see contacts). A vehicle will be available to transport anyone from the gate that needs assistance.

Come early for lunch at Gus's Drive in at 3131 Main Street, East Troy. This is on the west side of town. Plan on meeting about 12:30.

If you fly in, you can tie down on the main ramp, or park on the grass by Hangar L. Hangar is located on north side of runway, with flag painted on side. Call if you want to join us for lunch, and we'll pick you up (12:00 – 1:00). If you can let me know in advance, it would be appreciated.

Also on tap this month is our first Young Eagles rally of the season. Contact Dan for more information. Then brace yourself for a busy June!

Meeting called to order at 7:30

Jim had several announcements:

- Introduced Addison Tower, B52 pilot, as the evening's speaker.
- EAA 414 Officer reports:

 - Dave McCormick spoke about the EAA Work Party Weekends which our chapter participates in every year. He mentioned that our Chapter 217 (Kenosha) was recently mentioned in an article about volunteer efforts in the latest issue of Sport Aviation. Chapter 414 will be planning our volunteer weekend on June 27&28 2015.
 - Dan Feldman briefed the chapter on upcoming plans for our Chapter 414 Young Eagle rallies this summer. Dan stressed that these events are very well attended but require volunteers from the chapter to run, pilots and ground help. Please plan on helping out with our rallies.
 - First event will be May 9th at Stick and rudder. Ground volunteers plan on an 8:00a start and pilots 8:30 start. Dan will be opening up the website scheduling next week for the event.
 - Rallies planned for June 6th, August 8th, and the week after the Wings and Wheels event at Waukegan airport. Stay tuned for locations.
- Tim Stearns, Sonex builder and pilot, briefed the group on an Open House event at the Kenosha Airport on August 15th. Pencil in the date, more details to follow.
- Tim also briefed the chapter on the EAA Chapter 214 Sonex build that is going on up at the Chapter 214 Hangar at Kenosha. The group meets Wednesday evenings at 7p and Saturdays after lunch. All are welcome to stop by and help build the Sonex.
- Jim updated the chapter on the "Aviation Expo" planned for the Waukegan Airshow on September 12th and 13th. Airport authority has agreed to our plan for the event so we will begin in earnest to put the event together.
