We haven’t even begun with Veteran’s organizations, educational resources, or major corporate sponsors. Once project approval is received, we will begin an all-out fund raising program. A special thanks goes out to all who have raised preliminary donations – you are showing the Port Authority the depth of the true sentiment of the community.

Social period 7:00p to 7:32p Meeting called to order at 7:32pm

Jim Hull introduced FAA representatives present at this evenings meeting:

- Carolyn Remol, our guest speaker from the FAA, spoke about the FAA “Wings” program. A pilot proficiency and safety program. Carolyn delivered a very good presentation on the need for the WINGS program as well as how the program works.
- Chet Cybulski, another guest from the FAA, presented EAA 414 chapter member with the Wright Brothers Master Pilot Award. Chet presented Bob with some beautiful plaques and a lapel pin for him and his spouse. As a testament to Bob’s many years of flying Chet presented Bob with a packet of documents that the FAA has on him, *a very small packet of documents*. A nice memento of safe flying and the lack of intervention from the FAA.
 - To qualify for the award a pilot must have 50 years or more of safe flight operations. The candidate has demonstrated professionalism, skill and aviation expertise. This is the most prestigious award that the FAA issues.
 - For a candidate to be nominated for the award the FAA prefers to have folks familiar with the candidate to relate their experiences with them.
 - Jim Hull spoke for Bob and related his professionalism in the cockpit. Bob has always been very “cool under pressure” when flying. Bob has also given back to the flying community by flying over 350 Young Eagles over the years. Jim also related Bob’s aviation dark side – his desire to fly his Cri-Cri. Some seem to confuse the Cri-Cri with a radio controlled aircraft rather than a manned aircraft.
 - Dan Feldman related his experiences with Bob with the Young Eagle events, Bob being a regular pilot to help out and fly the youths. Bob has also wealth of information as a tech counselor to Dan and others.
 - Dave McCormick also commented on Bob’s dark side with more tales of the Cri-Cri.
 - Kelly Sikula, an employee of Bob’s, related how Bob has been an invaluable mentor and friend to her over the years.
- Jim proceeded with other general announcements.
 - Dan Feldman spoke about the Toys for Tots event
 - Confirmed for Nov 14 at AVP
 - Will serve coffee and donuts
 - Visiting aircraft can park at AVP ramp
 - The chapter will post signs in front of AVP
 - Next Young Eagle Rally is set for Oct 17th at Skill. We are looking for ground crew to help.
 - The Election Committee – Dan, Sam and John, spoke to the group regarding the upcoming election at our next chapter meeting. All leadership positions are available. If you are interested please contact someone in the Election Committee to let them know your interest. The Young Eagle Chair is also available if you are interested.
 - Jim spoke some more about the F-111A Aardvark project. Jim is working with the Port Authority to organize the disassembly and transport to Waukegan. The Port Authority is providing a hangar with facilities so that there will be an appropriate place to reassemble and refurbish the aircraft.
 - The Warbird Heritage Foundation is interested in acquiring a representative aircraft from the WWI era to fill the collection. The WHF has been considering building a kit Nieuport 27 and has approached the chapter for help. This may be a very interesting project to work on as a chapter.
