Meeting called to order at 7:35p

13 members in attendance.

Jim Hull started the meeting with announcements:

- Mike Fazio is taking orders for nametags. If you need a nametag please contact Mike and also include wording for the second line of the nametag. Nice to have something that may indicate an interest of yours, i.e. "Vans RV-7", "Sonex", "Hatz 1234".
- Chapter elections are coming up. An election committee has been formed to organize the process. Sam Battaglia, John Cecilia, and Dan Feldman are serving on the committee. All leadership positions are available.
- Wings and Wheels event is coming up at the Kenosha Airport. Chapter 217 is helping to organize and have asked for assistance from our chapter. Our chapter will handle the parking of vehicles. New to this year's event is a hangar dance and beer sales.
- The Waukegan Airshow was cancelled this year due to a resident on the airport perimeter being a bit too greedy in asking for compensation to vacate his house for the event. Next year's event is planned to be only a single day event. Our chapter is still planning on doing our "Affordable Flying Expo" at next year's event.
